

3 mystery objects:


- •What are we asking for?

Matthew 6:9-10

God's will (His desire)


God's <u>sovereign</u> will: the secret things (Deut. 29:29)

God's <u>moral</u> will: your sanctification (1 Thess. 4:3)

•God's sovereign will (desire) will be done.

- •If we ask for it, we will get it.
- •If we seek it, we will find it.
- •If we knock on it, it will open.

Do we pray for wants and needs?




We can pray for anything within God's moral will.




What reason stops me from praying for good gifts?
